1. The services for students with disabilities office (SSWD) will contact students with disabilities when they enroll.		
2. The IEP will determine the post-secondary education accommodations.		
3. If a disability is identified, the student will get accommodations in post-secondary education.		
4. SSWD coordinators will follow the student's progress, and communicate their grades, current class status, attendance, etc.		
5. Accommodations in the IEP will be followed in post-secondary SSWD office.		
6. The laws regarding students with disabilities are the same in high school and post-secondary.		
7. Parents may obtain information on their son/daughters' progress in postsecondary education by calling the SSWD office.		
8. The SSWD office will accept any LD testing done prior to college enrollment.		
9. If a student with a disability is accepted into college, there is a good chance they will be successful in their classes.		
10. Students with disabilities must register with the SSWD office.
